New white lines are coming for the Kettering Road

At school drop-off and pick-up times, Kettering Road is always busy and the number of cars parked along the section by the school increases significantly. Our local Police Community Support Officer (PCSO) holds regular drop-in surgeries during term time outside the school and, in conjunction with this event, the PCSO is able to monitor the parking situation.

All too often vehicles regularly park right up to the traffic calming chicane. In order to keep the chicane area free of parked vehicles and ensure the smooth flow of traffic at these busy times of the day, the Parish Council has offered its support to the painting of white line marking to indicate the extent of the area by the chicane to be kept clear of parked vehicles - painting will begin shortly.

Drop Kerbs at the Jubilee Drive junction with Kettering Road

Some of you will have seen that white H lines have been painted by the two drop-kerbs at the Kettering Road end of Jubilee Drive. Do not park on these white lines as to do so could render you liable to a ticket for obstruction, which may result in a fine and/or points on your license. The police also remind you not to park opposite the end of Jubilee Drive or on pavements / verges in the vicinity of the junction.
